If you've tried to use the Boundless app, which allows patrons to check out eBooks and eAudiobooks, and can't access your account, here's why. The Boundless app will cease on Nov. 17.

Checkout will no longer be available after Sunday; Nov. 2 and all holds will be cancelled on Nov. 16.

RAILS, our library consortium, has announced a new platform, The Palace Project app, that will replace Boundless, however, there will be a transition period to move the items from Boundless to the new app.

Here's the timetable:

Now- No longer able to place new holds in Boundless

Now- your checkout history and holds information will not transfer to the new app.

Make a list if that information is important to you.

Sunday, Nov. 2- Final day to check out any items in Boundless

Monday, Nov. 17 – Boundless defunct.

Tuesday, Dec. 2- The Palace Project app will be available for users to download, log in, and enjoy reading and listening again.

We will provide more information on this transition as we get it.

Baker and Taylor, the provider of Boundless, as well as a major supplier of books to libraries and book stores, has been forced to go out of business.
