### Palace Project: FAQs

#### Having Trouble Signing In?

The Palace Project app works with **iOS** and **Android** phones and tablets and can be found in the **Apple App Store** or **Google Play Store**, by searching for "The Palace Project."

Once downloaded, open and **search for "Paw Paw Public Library District."**

**BUT WAIT!** Your library card number will not work, so **you will need to sign up for a virtual library card** on the app.

The app will **NEED TO ACCESS YOUR LOCATION**. In order for it to work, you need be in **Paw Paw**, so this can be done in town or at the library.

It will send you an email so you can set up a login and password. After that, **you are ready to borrow!**

From these sales the library gets a percentage of the profit which aids in our library operations and collection management and expansion.

If you plan on bringing in more than a couple of boxes, please call ahead of time. Otherwise drop off when the library is open. If it's just a few items, you can put them in the library book drop in front of the Community Center.



#### **Expendable Elite: One Soldier's Journey Into Covert Warfare**



*Daniel Marvin*

## Libby FAQs

**Libby** has launched and is now live! Libby is a **free** app where you can enjoy **ebooks, digital audiobooks, and magazines** from the library. You can stream titles with Wi-Fi or mobile data, or download them for offline use and read. It will provide even more options for our patrons!


To get started, **download or open Libby** on your device (iOS devices: Apple App Store, Android devices: Google Play, Amazon Fire tablets: Amazon Appstore, Windows, Mac, and Chromebooks: [libbyapp.com](http://libbyapp.com)).

Once in the app, **search** for **Paw Paw Public Library District** (it will come up with the name "Rolling Prairie Consortium" which we are a part of). Select our library and, when prompted, enter your library card number.

If the app will **not let you sign-in**, your **library card** might be **expired!** Come into the library and we can get your card renewed and updated in Libby. We can also help you to figure out what else might be going wrong if it is not an issue with your card.
